

## ANNUAL **REPORT** JULY 1, 2023 – JUNE 30, 2024

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This year was a time of sustained growth, change, and celebration at the Aurora Public Library District. Our new bookmobile finally arrived in October 2023, with a vibrant color scheme that anticipated our new brand, which was unveiled in June 2024. Those two major events bookended a year that saw incredible growth in every measure of library use – more people visited our libraries, more people attended our programs, more books were checked out, more questions answered, more public computers were used than any year since 2019.

As good as these numbers are – and they are great! – the impact that the library had on the community this year is the real story. A grant from Comcast made possible a series of classes in English and Spanish that teaches computer and software skills, so that participants have the skills they need to advance their careers and improve their lives. Lawyers in the Library partners with local legal aid organizations to bring pro bono help to residents who need help navigating the legal system. Storytimes in many languages are regular offerings at all of our locations, because connecting kids and their adults with the joy of reading makes the biggest difference of all.

There's so much happening at your library, and through it all we're planning for the future. The library board approved a new strategic plan in October 2023, and you'll start seeing our new mission, vision, and strategic directions in the next few months. We also spent a lot of time planning for Eola Road Branch renovations, and construction will begin in fall 2024.

So many good things are happening, and we look forward to so much more progress in the coming year.

### **Building an Inclusive Library**

#### Menstrual Products at all Library locations

With grant funding from the ZamZam Foundation and the Aurora Public Library District Foundation, APLD is proud to offer free menstrual products at all facilities beginning in **September 2023**. Products can be found in all restrooms, welcoming customers to take whatever they need.



#### **Community Voices**

**September 15, 2023** APLD launched Community Voices, a library initiative to provide space for community members to share their individual stories. The mission of Community Voices is to celebrate diverse experiences, foster connections, cultivate empathy, and nurture a sense of belonging at the library. Our first exhibit highlighted Hispanic Heritage and featured 12 Aurorans including State Representative Barbara

Hernandez and Claudia Urrutia owner of Quinta de los Reyes. The exhibit was followed by a panel discussion in partnership with local Aurora business, Nide Jardin.





### **Building New Partnerships & Nurturing Existing Ones**

The library continues to seek out new partnerships with local businesses, organizations and the city whether it's through a partnership in programs, library visibility at community events or cross promotion. A few events include an Inclusive job fair in April 2024 which welcomed several local organizations to



the library's atrium and a partnership with the Columbian Express Consulate which had customers arriving at 4 a.m. ready to receive passport, ID, and notary services.

## Connecting the Community to Evolving Services & Technologies

#### **Open Computers & Faxing**

Wanting to break down barriers, APLD launched open computer labs and free faxing for all customers. Having an open computer lab allows for shorter waits and for anyone to use our



computers regardless of library card status.



#### **Comcast Grant**

In partnership with Family Focus, the library was awarded a \$30,000 grant from Comcast to provide additional computer education to library customers and Family Focus clients. Weekly classes began in May 2024, with Comcast providing laptops to individuals who complete the course.

#### **Digital Archives**

**May 2024** the Aurora Public Library District's treasured collection of historical photographs became accessible online through the Illinois Digital Archives (IDA). This digital initiative made Aurora's unique history available to a wider audience than ever before.





#### Solar Eclipse

On **April 8, 2024** the library celebrated the solar eclipse by hosting a live viewing of the eclipse. The weeks leading up the library distributed 7,000 solar eclipse glasses.

#### **New Website**

The library launched a new website in **August 2023**, featuring a fresh, clean design, enhanced accessibility options, and a virtual tour of the Santori Library.

#### New Bookmobile

The library welcomed our 6th Bookmobile with a pop-up party on **October 2, 2023**. Its official opening was Friday, October 6, 2023 where a ribbon cutting ceremony welcomed the Bookmobile to the Aurora community. Included in the month-long festivities was a check presentation with State Representatives recognizing a \$400,000 grant , a Bookmobile ride-a-long with popular podcast show, Good Morning Aurora and an exhibit



highlighting the history of bookmobiles in Aurora.

#### **New Brand**

**June 1, 2024** the Aurora Public Library District launched a new brand! This 7th logo in APLD's history, includes a fox that embodies progress and innovation. In addition, the Foundation's new logo mirrors the library's logo symbolizing partnership and a shared vision. The new brand also



includes APLD's first ever mascot, a fox! Community members submitted names and with over 300 name submissions, Rory was chosen as our furry little friend's name. Along with the new brand, a transition plan was delivered to all staff welcoming all departments, branches and services to transition to its new look in an unified

Within 2 weeks of the public announcement most public facing items were updated including staff name tags, website and flyers.
